



Already possessing decades of stage experience in previous bands, drummer Tony Randolph, bassist Tracy McKee, and guitarist Larry Shepard joined together in late 2012. Over the next six years they played bars, clubs, and festivals across Indiana and the surrounding Midwestern states, as well as larger venues including:

In 2016 they recorded and released their first EP “Chapter One”. In addition to releasing the album, they shot and released music videos for the songs “Who Don’t Love A Love Song” and “If A Beer Could Make It Better”.

In early 2019, the band brought in singer/songwriter Eric Shaw from Westfield, IN and re-launched the band as SouthRidge. SouthRidge carries on the band's style of performing classic country hits from the 1960's through today while also incorporating a healthy dose of Southern Rock and Classic Rock hits. The band continues to perform across Indiana and the Midwest, keeping crowds dancing and singing along!
